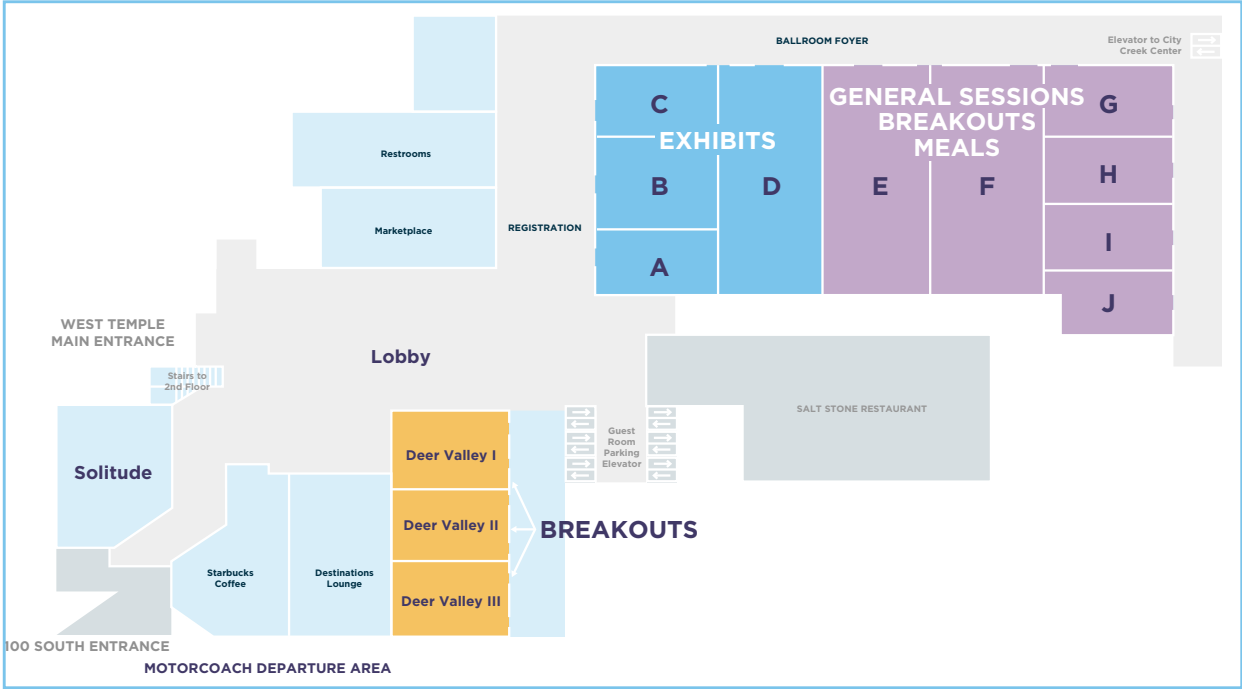

SECOND FLOOR

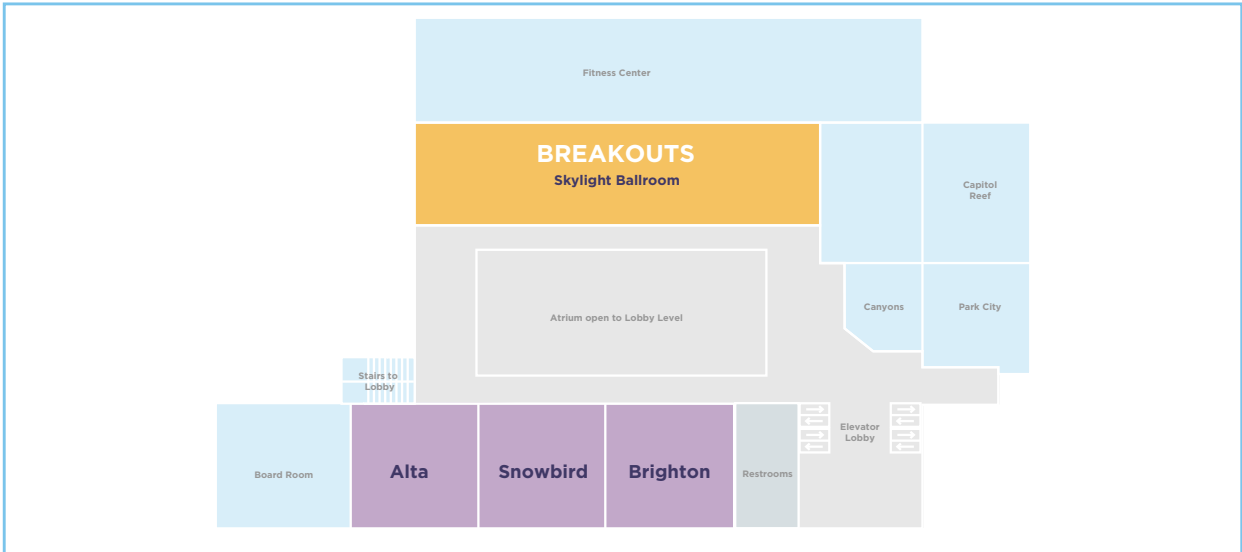
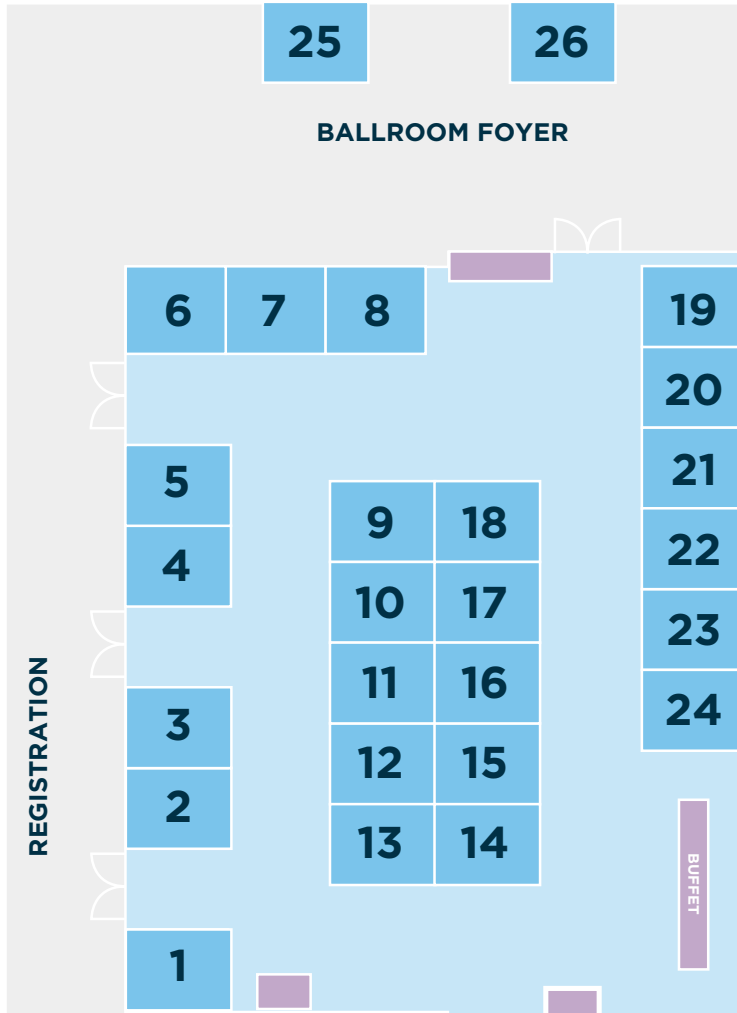
