



How MPOs Can Use This Email Template

This template is **intended to help MPOs educate congressional transportation staff** about how the BASICS Act relates to existing federal transportation planning requirements and regional delivery responsibilities. It is designed to be informational, educational, and easily tailored to local context.

Recommended use:

- Send to **US House and Senate transportation staff representing your region**.
- Adapt for **individual offices** rather than mass distribution.

Best practices:

- Keep the email to **one page**.
- Send from a **known MPO staff contact** (e.g., executive director, planning director, or federal liaison).
- **Copy AMPO Legislative Director, Katie Economou** (keconomou@ampo.org) on the email.
- Coordinate with AMPO if staff request broader national or legislative context.
